Goals of Revocation Reason Proposal

Clarify TLS BR Sec. 4.9.1.1: Reorganize and refine Section 4.9.1.1 to better define revocation reasons and reason codes, reducing ambiguity.

Re-align Use of Some Reason Codes: Realign some revocation reasons into coherent categories:
key soundness (1=keyCompromise);
identity accuracy (9=privilegeWithdrawn) DCV, CAA, and authority;
and **administrative / lifecycle management** (4=superseded) for more predictable and meaningful CRL data.

Improve Handling of Benign Cases: Direct use of CRLReason #4 (superseded) for minor compliance or administrative revocations, including for many mass revocations.

Support Ecosystem Consistency and Transparency: Simplify overlapping or duplicative language, use RFC 5280 codes, and create clearer mapping for data analysis of revocations.
